### **DRAFT TRIBAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT LEASE FOR THE WenasgwəllaʔaW (GENERATIONS) BUILDING**

The Quinault Indian Nation (QIN) has released a Draft Tribal Environmental Impact Report (TEIR) for the proposed lease for the WenasgwəllaʔaW (Generations) building (Proposed Project). The TEIR analyzes potentially significant on- and off-Reservation environmental impacts of the Proposed Project and identifies appropriate mitigation to reduce identified impacts. The Tribe is hereby requesting public comments on the Draft TEIR.

**Project Location:** 1651 Kla Ook Wa Drive, Taholah, WA 98587, to the east of the Roger Saux Health Center

**Project Description:** The Proposed Project consists of an approximately 30,000 square foot building and associated parking lot. The Generations Building will house the Senior Program, Head Start and Early Head Start programs, Day Care and a room apiece for Management Information Services, Adult Education, and Recreation. The proposed project will contribute to the safety of Taholah residents by relocating child and senior programs out of the tsunami zone and serving as a temporary emergency shelter, as well as providing for upgraded facilities that meet the current standards for child care facilities.
