SALMON RIVER 2025 FALL FISHERY SPORT FISHING REGULATION – 01

TO: Quinault Tribal Members

SUBJECT: Sport Fishing on the Salmon River – Stat weeks 36-48

<u>FISHERY/PURPOSE</u>: To open the Salmon River within the Quinault Reservation to hook and line fishing consistent with the 2025 Queets River Fall Management Plan.

SEASON: September 1, 2025 – November 30, 2025

AREA: The Salmon River within the Quinault Indian Reservation.

LIMITS: The fishery is open to taking the following species and the daily bag limits:

Species	Daily Limits
Adult Coho (greater than 20 inches)	3 fish (Sept 1-30), 2 fish (October 1-November 30)
Adult Chinook (greater than 24 inches)	0 fish (No retention)
Jack Salmon (chinook less than 24	12 fish
inches and coho less than 20 inches)	
Steelhead	1 fish
Cutthroat	2 fish
Native Char	2 fish

GEAR/RESTRICTIONS:

- Each fisher is limited to the use of one (1) fishing pole.
- Snagging is prohibited.
- Walking on redds (egg nests) is prohibited.

Recommendation: Anglers cease fishing after adult salmon or steelhead limits are caught to minimize congestion in small fishing areas.

Fish Handling Requirements: The following fish handling procedures can improve the survival of released fish.

- Do not remove the fish from the water.
- Do not net the fish but if netting is necessary, use knotless nets or rubber mesh nets.
- Use a hook remover when hooks are imbedded in the mouth of jaw.
- If a fish has swallowed the hook, cut the leader.

Fish caught in this fishery CANNOT be sold for any purpose.

- Keep fingers and tools away from the eyes and gills of the fish.

PARTICIPATION: An enrolled Quinault tribal member must accompany all non-Quinault fishers. The Quinault member must be within 100 feet of their non-Quinault guest/client while fishing. A limit of three (3) non-member persons can participate in the fishery accompanied by a single enrolled Quinault tribal member.

REPORTING: All Quinault-member catch shall be reported to the QDNR permits office in Taholah at Ext. 7372 within 72 hours of capture or to mycatch@quinault.org. Quinault-licensed guides shall report catches by themselves and their clients in logbooks provided by the QDNR permits office.
