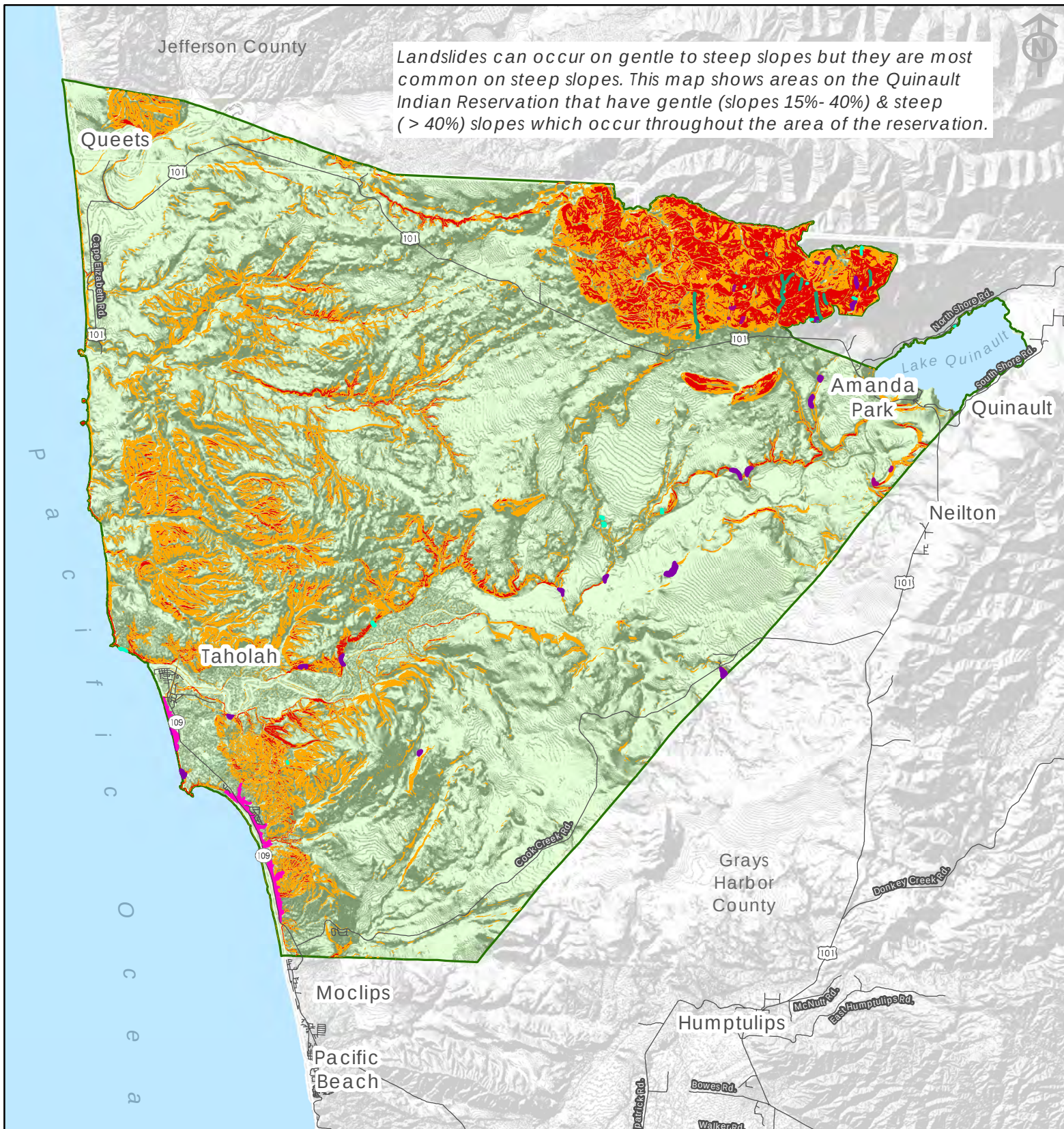


Jefferson County

Landslides can occur on gentle to steep slopes but they are most common on steep slopes. This map shows areas on the Quinault Indian Reservation that have gentle (slopes 15%- 40%) & steep (> 40%) slopes which occur throughout the area of the reservation.
